

MCPO Jonathan K. Harrington Command Master Chief Sector Honolulu United States Coast Guard



Master Chief Jonathan Harrington is originally from Warrenton, Virginia. He joined the Coast Guard in November 2002 and is currently the Command Master Chief of SECTOR Honolulu, HI.

His previous assignments were Officer in Charge of CG Station Eatons Neck in Northport, NY, Officer in Charge of CG Station Kings Point New York, CG Station Islamorada, Florida where he served as the Executive Petty Officer. He has served on three Coast Guard Cutters including First Lieutenant aboard the CGC KANKAKEE in Memphis, Tennessee.



BMCM Harrington also served as the Operations Petty Officer aboard the CGC HAWKSBILL in Monterey, California, and he started his career by striking Boatswains Mate aboard the CGC TAMPA in Portsmouth, Virginia. Between his sea tours, he was an underway instructor for Boatswain's Mate "A" school at the Boat Forces and Cutter Operations TRACEN Yorktown, Virginia. He was also the First Lieutenant at CG Station Hatteras Inlet, North Carolina, and a Tactical Coxswain at CG Station Oak Island, North Carolina.

Master Chief Harrington's personal awards include the Coast Guard Commendation Medal, three Coast Guard Achievement Medals, three Commandant's Letter of Commendation ribbons, and five CG Good Conduct Medals among other personal and unit awards. He holds a 100-ton Merchant Mariner License and is a graduate of the Chief Petty Officers Academy (Class 227).
